# Headteacher New Road Primary School

## Purpose of role

To lead and manage the School, engaging with the local community, the Governing Body, and Medway LA in order to continually improve the outcomes for pupils.

# Management and Leadership

- To provide inspirational leadership to the staff to ensure that the pupils achieve their full potential and to be the lead teaching professional
- To develop and maintain policies that provide a framework for excellent teaching and provide a safe and secure environment for pupils and staff and to ensure that all such policies are reviewed periodically by the Governing Body
- To ensure that every child is stretched and challenged to make academic progress and that appropriate and challenging targets are set and met
- To provide the Governing Body with sound data and other information to enable the Governing body to hold the Head to account and to assess the progress of the School
- To be familiar with current best practice in all areas of the curriculum, assessment, monitoring and evaluation throughout the School
- To be responsible for preparing and updating the School Improvement Plan for consideration by the Governing Body, staff, parents and pupils, where appropriate, and to ensure it is an active document
- To develop and maintain effective policies covering all aspects of teaching, discipline, behaviour, curriculum etc.
- To seek opportunities to collaborate with other Schools in order to share best practice and make best use of resources
- To ensure that decisions and actions about pupil attainment and progress are based on sound data

## Resources

- To control, allocate and monitor all School financial and material resources
- To ensure that the budget is allocated in accordance with the School Improvement Plan and individual training needs and development targets for staff
- To ensure that all equipment, facilities and the site itself are reasonably safe and that all necessary risk assessments and health and safety checks are undertaken
- To ensure that the School achieves good value for money in its expenditure
- To ensure that all accounting, budgeting, monitoring, and auditing is carried out in accordance with the appropriate modules, guidelines as laid down by the Local Education Authority

# Staffing

- To lead the Senior Management Team
- To develop and manage a suitable staffing structure for the School
- To manage policies on pay, performance management, staff development and staff conduct
- To provide opportunities for and to support the continuing development of all staff
- To monitor and support the work of NQTs and Advanced Skills Teachers

## Parents and the Community

- To maintain and continually develop good relations with parents and carers, and links with the local community
- To ensure that regular information about the progress of the children is given to parents and guardians
- To be accessible to parents and carers

• To actively promote the School, upholding its reputation and attractiveness to existing and prospective parents

## Pupils

- To assist all pupils happily to achieve the School's aims within the School environment
- To ensure that safeguarding policies are rigorously applied so that all children are safe in School and that any safeguarding concerns are acted on promptly
- To ensure that the children are engaged in relevant, appropriate and balanced educational activities of high quality
- To ensure the requirements of the National Curriculum are fully met
- To ensure that pupils individual needs are met
- To set standards for and to monitor the assessment and recording of children's progress
- To implement a curriculum that recognises the importance of social, moral, spiritual and physical development as well as academic achievement.

## Governors

- To maintain an effective working relationship with the Governing Body advising and assisting governors in the discharge of their duties
- To report to the Governing Body on all relevant matters affecting the conduct, performance and standards of the School, pupils and staff
- To keep governors fully informed of School events and issues
- To attend all meetings of the Governing Body and appropriate subcommittees of the Governing Body [It is our preference that the Head teacher becomes a Governor]
