King's Farm Primary School is a Local Authority maintained school located in the heart of the community within King's Farm housing estate, Gravesend. The school is a well-resourced learning environment, set in spacious grounds. Originally built in the late 1960's, the school has continued to be extended and modernised over the years to enhance pupils learning experiences. There are currently 330 primary age pupils on role and in addition, the school also has its own on site Nursery provision.

King's Farm Primary School offers a wide range of extra-curricular clubs which include a well attended breakfast club and various after school activities. The school has worked hard to forge links with the local community and in September 2015, federated with Ifield School serving special educational needs in the Gravesham district and the lead school in the Thames Teaching Alliance.

Also serving the local community is an onsite Children's Centre. King's Farm Primary School is proud of these links as we continue to work closely with all agencies to serve our community.

King's Farm Primary School has a supportive Governing Body federated with Ifield School, providing a mix of both established and new Governors with a wide range of skills to assist in the Leadership and Management of the school.
