Key duties and responsibilities:

- 7. Work with the pupil on therapy or care programmes, designed and supervised by a therapist/care.
- 8. Assist with break-time supervision including facilitating games and activities.
- 9. Assist with escorting pupils on educational visits.
- 10. Support pupils in using basic ICT
- 11. Undertake moving and handling activities as required.
