You will be a key player in ensuring the smooth day to day running of facilities and assisting with the operation and maintenance of the school so that our pupils are able to flourish and carry on with their learning. We have been judged as 'Outstanding' by Ofsted and our desire is that this is evidenced across the whole school site and the successful candidate will be somebody who takes extreme pride in helping to keep the school; both inside and out, in immaculate condition.



This key role has many aspects, but will include the following:

Site Safety and Security | General Repairs and Maintenance | Hygiene; Health & Safety | Grounds Maintenance | Operation of Heating Systems | Statutory Checks | Asset Checks | Porterage | Liaison with Contractors

It is essential that any applicants have a flexible attitude to be able to meet the ever changing and on-going needs of the school day. You will also be somebody with a strong work ethic, a pro-active approach to the job and has good IT skills. The role may sometimes involve working early mornings, late nights and weekends (with notice) but the core hours for this role will be 20 hours a week, Monday to Friday in school hours, depending on the needs of the day. This is a term time position with two additional weeks worked in school holidays. Some experience is desirable but not essential as full training will be offered to the right person. It will also involve regular contact with children and staff so the ability to relate to both children and adults is essential.

The salary for this role will be £9,240, paid on Kent Range 3 (FTE of £19,293). You will also have the opportunity to join the Local Government Pension Scheme.
