JOB SUMMARY

To be responsible and accountable for the supervision of pupils during the lunch break; ensuring their safety and welfare; ensuring that good standards of behaviour are observed and that meals take place in an orderly manner.

MAIN DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Presenting up the children in an orderly manner and leading them to the entrance of the dining area from either the play area or classrooms.
- Supervision of children within the dining area to ensure the meal takes place in an orderly manner and good table manners are observed.
- Assisting children with eating, use of cutlery and utensils.
- Assisting children in clearing away their plates at the end of the meal.
- Supervision of children from dining area to cloakroom.
- Assisting children changing for play.
- To hand children over to Teaching Assistants from classrooms and other out of bounds areas, inside and outside.

- Supervision of children into and within play areas.
- Reporting any injuries, other than the most minor cuts and grazes, to the designated First Aider.
- To be aware of and contribute to the development of the philosophy and ethos of the federation and do everything possible to promote it positively.
- To be aware of safety requirements and report any potential hazards to the person responsible for Health and Safety.
- To be aware of child safeguarding and welfare requirements and report any potential concerns to the person responsible for Child Protection.
- To attend training sessions as and when required.
