- Work closely with the Lead Teachers to support the schools' programmes of sport;
- Take the lead in developing colleagues' skills and aptitude as sports coaches by leading a culture of continuing professional development and providing training opportunities and courses to support the schools' sporting aims.

- Head up a sporting partnership programme that makes VIAT facilities available to the local and national sporting communities, in accordance with the Trust's charitable goals;
