Education and Training

- Qualified Teacher Status.
- Satisfactory Completion of Teacher Induction Period (NQT or ECT)
- Good level of Literacy and Numeracy (GCSE Grade C or above or equivalent).
- Additional qualification/ training / previous experience in special education.
- Recent training in First Aid, SEN and other subjects as appropriate.

Relevant Experience

- Recent experience of teaching pupils with a range of special educational needs.
- Experience of involvement in the statutory assessment process for EHCP, e.g. observations, paperwork.
- Substantial post qualified experience of working as a teacher with children aged 3-4.
- Ability to plan and provide a variety of stimulating activities and learning experiences suitable to the age and development of the children.
- Previous experience of teaching pupils within a specialist provision.
- Prior experience of managing a setting, ideally in a similar environment.
- Experience of devising activities for the needs of children indoors and outdoors incorporating continuous provision.
- Experience of delivering a high standard of care to children with a range of difficulties.

Personal Attributes and Skills

- Ability to effectively manage, motivate and act as a positive role model, leading by example.
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to lead a nursery team and develop positive relationships with colleagues, parents and children.
- Positive, enthusiastic and hardworking.
- Excellent communication with external and internal staff and all members of the public including agencies, parents, Ofsted.
- Displays commitment to the protection and safeguarding of children.
- Ability to write clear and accurate reports and observations to support the statutory assessment process.
- Proactive and innovative approach to challenges and ideas, plus strong problem solving capabilities
- Good understanding of Equal Opportunities legislation
