## 1. PURPOSE OF JOB

To work with teachers to support teaching and learning, providing general and specific assistance to pupils and staff under the direction, guidance and direct supervision of the classroom teacher. To provide support to teachers in order to raise children's achievement and attainment in all areas.

## 2. KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Meet Teaching Assistant Standards
- Work with individuals or small groups of pupils in the classroom under the direct supervision of teaching staff and feed back to the teacher to facilitate pupil progress.
- Support the teacher in behaviour management and keeping pupils on task.
- Support pupils in social and emotional well-being, reporting problems to the teacher as appropriate.
- Prepare and clear up learning environment and resources, including photocopying, filing and the display and presentation of pupils work and contribute to maintaining a safe environment.

Teaching Assistants in this role may also undertake some or all of the following:

- 1. Support children's learning including directly teaching small intervention groups.
- 2. Record basic pupil data
- 3. Assist with break-time supervision including facilitating games and activities.
- 4. Assist with escorting pupils on educational visits
- 5. Support pupils in using basic ICT
- 6. Supervise assessments/statutory testing.
- 7. Assist with pupils' personal needs where appropriate including toileting, hygiene, dressing and eating, as well as help with social, welfare and health matters, reporting problems to the teacher as appropriate. Physically assist pupils in activities (may involve lifting, where mobility is an issue).
- 8. Understand and comply with policies and procedures relating to child protection, equal opportunities, health, safety, security, confidentiality and data protection, reporting concerns to an appropriate person in order to maintain a safe and secure learning environment.
- 9. Assist with pupils on therapy or care programmes, designed and supervised by a therapist/teacher.
