1	Teaching and	Learning	Promote, support and facilitate independent learning
	Learning		Assist tutor with learning activities and contribute ideas for meeting the objectives of each session.
			Support the learners in accessing learning activities individually or in small/whole groups as directed by the tutor to enable learners' progress towards their outcomes.
			Be aware of and support differences to ensure all learners have equal access to opportunities to learn and develop.
			Support the development of learner communication skills using both spoken and augmentative communication approaches.
			Establish productive working relationships with learners, acting as a role model and setting high expectations.
		Assessment	Contribute towards and review individual learner outcomes and strategies.
			Observe, monitor and record the progress of learners both using the appropriate format as advised by the tutor including learning, behaviour and wellbeing, safeguarding etc. (including liaising with
			therapists) as directed in order to support the tutor deliver the specific learning programmes set for each person.

		Environment	Ensure the maintenance of a clean, orderly and safe working environment making sure that equipment/resources/materials are set out on time and as per instructions received and used safely to enable

			Assist where necessary with display, preparation and organisation of learning materials to ensure effective and efficient teaching.
		Resources	Ensure resources are replaced in good order in communal areas of the college to ensure the learning needs of all learners can be met.
			Make materials/visual supports for tutors or support the learner in doing so that will enhance learning.
