The Role:

- a Level 3 qualification in Early Years as a minimum,
- an interest in Steiner Waldorf education and / or Pikler/RIE pedagogy,
- a proven ability to relate to and inspire children,
- the capacity to communicate and work well with colleagues and parents.

The Assistant will work in our May Tree Kindergarten under the mentorship of an experienced kindergarten teacher. Their role will include promoting the overall welfare of the children, maintaining an environment for positive creative play and the celebration of festivals. The afternoon activities take place outdoors.

Kindergarten Assistants work as part of a team with the kindergarten teachers, school teachers, the school management team, trustees and administrative staff.
