Job Summary:

The postholder will undertake responsibility for the learning, behaviour and progress of classes during the absence of the designated teacher. Undertaking pre-prepared activities provided by a teacher, you will be required to create conditions for effective student learning, through our schools Mastery Curriculum to ensure every child reaches their potential.

Key Result Areas:

- To supervise classes during the short-term absence of the class teacher.
- Ensure that students develop a love of learning through continuous and consistent focus on achievement, ensuring that all students make progress during cover lessons.

- To ensure the school behaviour policy is adhered to when covering lessons.
- To provide feedback to staff as to the progress made by students in class.

- To work as part of a team to support the transition of new students.
- To assist with the administration as required.
