Starting Secondary School

To ensure a smooth transition from primary to secondary school, we offer a comprehensive and unique range of events designed to help students feel confident and prepared ahead of starting Year 7.

Our transition programme includes a unique transition day filled with engaging activities, two traditional induction days for students, as well as an information evening for students and their families. Additionally, new students and their parents are invited to attend one-to-one meetings with members of the senior leadership team to discuss individual needs and interests.

We also run a successful Year 5 outreach programme in term 6, giving primary school children the opportunity to explore and familiarise themselves with

our school and staff, and participate in taster sessions in a wide range of subjects.

Our aim is to help students settle into the school as quickly and smoothly as possible, by making them feel a sense of belonging prior to starting Year 7.

Curriculum
