

PROPOSED JOB DESCRIPTION - COVER SUPERVISOR

Job details

Job title: Cover Supervisor

Grade: KR5

Reporting to: Faculty Lead

MAIN PURPOSE

To supervise whole classes undertaking pre-prepared activities provided by a teacher during the short-term absence of a classroom teacher. The primary focus is to maintain order and to keep students on task.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Supervise pre-prepared activities and self-directed learning in the absence of teachers to provide continuity of learning for students.
- 2. Prepare the classroom/outside areas for lessons, ensuring that resources are available and cleared away at the end of the lessons as appropriate.
- 3. Manage the behaviour of students whilst they are undertaking work.
- 4. Collect any completed work after the lesson and return it to the appropriate teacher.
- 5. Report back as appropriate using agreed referral procedures on the behaviour of students during the class, and any issues arising.
- 6. Support individuals or small groups as directed by the teacher.
- 7. Undertake exam invigilation as required.

QUALIFICATIONS	Level 2 Diploma (or equivalent).
EXPERIENCE	Successful recent experience of working with children of relevant age.
SKILLS AND ABILITIES	Ability to apply behaviour management policies and strategies which contribute to a purposeful learning environment. Must have the ability to work calmly under pressure and have the ability to adapt quickly and effectively to changing circumstances/situations.
KNOWLEDGE	Knowledge of procedures for supervising pre-prepared learning activities, and providing feedback. Specialist knowledge of behaviour management. Knowledge and compliance with policies and procedures relevant to safeguarding, child protection, and health and safety.
