#### JOB PURPOSE

To work under the instruction/guidance of senior/teaching staff to support the delivery of quality learning and teaching and to help raise standards of achievement for all pupils in PE.

#### MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILTIES

- Support the PE Lead to deliver PE/Sport provision across the school including competitions and Sports Day events
- To undertake work/care/support programmes to enable access to learning for pupils and to assist the teacher in the delivery of PE and sporting activity
- Support the SENCO to plan, deliver and assess interventions linked to physical development; ensuring the inclusion and acceptance of all children
- Attend PE meetings in place of PE Lead when required
- Maintain assessment records for PE
- Develop a knowledge of a range of learning support needs and to develop an understanding of the specific needs of the pupils
- Establish a constructive relationship with the pupils and interact with them according to individual needs;
- Establish appropriate, constructive relationships with parents/carers; signposting to the class teacher for specific enquires
- Attend and participate in relevant meetings, and training, as required
- Assist with the preparation and maintenance of equipment/resources required to meet lesson plans/relevant learning activities to support the delivery of an enriched curriculum.

#### Other areas of responsibility

- > Organise, communicate and deliver lunchtime and after school clubs
- > Break time, lunch time and gate duty.

The employee is expected to undertake any other duties which from time to time may be required and be relevant and commensurate with the post, as deemed necessary by the Headteacher.
