Qualifications

GCSE in English and Maths or equivalent

Experience and Professional Attributes

The candidate must show evidence of:

- working with children across the primary phase,
- screening for receptive and expressive language
- planning and delivering Speech and Language programmes.
- adapting programmes to individualise learning
- identifying tools and strategies to support the child in whole class learning.
- Liaising with colleagues effectively, including external agencies
- excellent written and verbal communication
- an understanding of effective learning environments.
- commitment to ensuring the wellbeing of all learners
- commitment to inclusive practice
- good ICT skills
- the ability to work to set targets for learners to ensure progress
- a commitment to further personal development

In addition to this experience, the following would be advantageous:

- a track record of supporting pupils with Development Language Disorders, Autism and EAL
- the ability to build interactions and turn-taking behaviours with children with communication and interaction difficulties.
- an understanding of sensory needs.

The candidate must have the ability to

- create a rapport with pupils, colleagues, parents and the wider community
- use positive language to ensure good learning behaviours
- be patient and calm under pressure
- demonstrate empathy
- be reflective and adapt their own practice
