Key Responsibilities

- Replenish hand towels and toilet rolls as required.
- Ensure health and safety procedures are followed and report any concerns and/or defects to the Assistant Site Manager.
- Attend in-house training courses as required
- Undertake the mechanical cleaning and polishing of hard floor areas as required
- Undertake deep cleaning, as directed by the Site Manager, to include window cleaning, moving
 furniture to clean behind it, skirting boards, walls, floors, tables, chairs and other furniture etc, to
 ensure all areas are clean and fresh.
- Undertake locking up duties in the event of an emergency
