
## **Overall Job Purpose:**

The successful candidate will play a vital role in supporting the delivery of high-quality practical food lessons, ensuring a safe, well-prepared, and engaging learning environment for all students.

## Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Support teachers during practical food lessons.
- Prepare and organise ingredients, equipment and resources.
- Maintain high standards of hygiene and cleanliness in food rooms.
- Order and manage stock and supplies, staying within budget.
- Implement food safety procedures, allergy protocols, and health & safety checks.
- Assist with administrative tasks including inventory records and lesson prep.
