Job Purpose

- To support the work of the teacher and SENCO/Inclusion Team
- Enhance the child's learning and development by:
 - o working one-to-one with a pupil to support their learning
 - o promoting the child's independence through understanding when to provide input and when to step back
 - o provide additional information for the teacher in their assessments of the pupil's attainment and progress
 - o working with a child with learning difficulties or disabilities
 - o other duties as identified by the class teacher or senior leadership team (SLT).

Main duties and responsibilities

Duties

- Assist in the educational and social development of the child under the direction and guidance of the Headteacher, SENCO and class teacher.
- Assist in the implementation of the Provision Plan for the child and keep records as directed in relation to these interventions.
- Assist with monitoring of the child's progress as directed by the class teacher / SENCO / SLT.
- Provide support for the child inside and outside the classroom to enable them to fully participate in activities.
- Support the child by understanding when to step back and when to intervene and provide direct support.
- Work with other professionals, such as speech therapists and occupational therapists, as necessary.
- Support the child with emotional or behavioural challenges and help develop their social skills.
- Recognise and act on own professional development needs as appropriate.
- Ask for support where necessary and respond to training and feedback.

Standards and Quality Assurance

- Understand that it is our statutory responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of all children
- Support the aims and ethos of the school.
- Set a good example in terms of dress, punctuality and attendance.
- Attend team meetings during working hours.
- Undertake professional duties that may be reasonably assigned by the SLT.
- Be proactive in matters relating to health and safety.

Other Duties

- Provide supervision of children during break time, either inside or on the playground.
- Promote and encourage the playing of games, activities and social development as well as ensuring the children's safety.
- Other reasonable duties.
