

The Role

To provide a comprehensive cleaning service to the school, ensuring that all areas (classrooms, corridors, toilets, and offices) are maintained to a high standard of cleanliness and hygiene. To contribute to a safe, welcoming, and pleasant learning environment for students and staff.

The Package

The successful candidate will work 25 hours per week Monday to Friday 1pm to 6pm during term time only.

Key Responsibilities and Duties

1. General Cleaning Operations

- Floors: Sweep, vacuum, mop, and polish/buff floors in classrooms, corridors, halls, and stairs.
- Surfaces: Dust, damp wipe, and clean furniture, ledges, window sills, and skirting boards.
- Sanitation: Sanitising touch points. Deep clean and sanitize toilets, urinals, sinks, and changing rooms, ensuring consumables (soap, toilet roll, paper towels) are replenished.
- Fixtures: Clean internal glass, mirrors, handrails, and whiteboard/chalkboard trays.
- Waste: Empty bins, replace liners, and dispose of waste in designated external collection points.

2. Health & Safety

- Chemical Safety: strictly adhere to COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health) regulations regarding the storage and use of cleaning chemicals.
- Equipment: Operate cleaning machinery (e.g., floor buffers, vacuums) safely and report any defects to the Site Manager immediately.
- Signage: Use "Wet Floor" signs and other safety markers to protect students and staff during cleaning hours.

3. Site Security & Maintenance

- Check that windows and doors in assigned areas are closed and locked after cleaning.
- Report any maintenance issues (e.g., broken lights, leaks, graffiti, or damaged furniture) to the Site Manager.

4. Periodic Deep Cleaning

- Undertake deep cleaning duties as required (e.g., carpet shampooing, high-level dusting, stripping and sealing floors).
