Core Purpose

To support the delivery of high-quality Early Years provision within the Nursery, ensuring that all children are safe, nurtured and engaged in meaningful learning experiences. The Teaching Assistant will work as part of the Nursery team to promote children's development, welfare and well-being in line with the EYFS Statutory Framework.

Key Responsibilities

Learning & Development

- Support children's learning through high-quality interactions that extend vocabulary, thinking and problem-solving.
- Assist in planning, preparing and setting up engaging continuous provision environments.
- Support small-group and adult-led activities as directed by the Nursery Manager/Teacher.
- Observe children's learning and contribute to assessments and records in line with school policy.
- Promote language-rich, play-based learning across the EYFS.

Child Welfare & Personal Care

- Support children with personal care routines (e.g. toileting, handwashing, dressing).
- Follow safeguarding procedures at all times and report concerns promptly.
- Ensure children are safe, supervised and supported with emotional regulation and well-being.
- Help maintain a calm, nurturing atmosphere that reflects the school's values.

Environment & Organisation

- Help maintain a clean, well-organised and stimulating environment indoors and outdoors.
- Support the setting up and clearing away of resources each session.
- Ensure equipment is used safely and effectively.

Teamwork & Communication

- Work collaboratively with colleagues to ensure consistency of routines and expectations.
 - Communicate professionally with parents, carers and other professionals as required.
 - Participate in staff meetings, CPD and supervision sessions as appropriate.
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General Duties


- Uphold and model the school's Christian vision and values.
