Background information



- Oasis Academy Isle of Sheppey is an 11 to 18 larger than average sized secondary school.
- The Academy became part of the Oasis multi-academy trust in January 2014.
- The vast majority of students are from White British backgrounds. A very small proportion of students speaks English as an additional language.
- The proportion of students supported by the pupil premium and those looked after by the local authority is above the national average.
- The proportion of disabled students and those with special educational needs is above the national average.





Care and Support

Features of our provision include:

- an induction process is offered to all new staff both teaching and support staff;
- NQTs have a 2 lesson reduction in their timetables and NQTs also have a tailored induction programme of regular sessions covering topics such as classroom behaviour management, child protection, teaching and learning, preparing for teaching audits and department reviews;
- regular, whole staff, year team and Learning Area briefings provide clear information about current activities across the Academy;
- annual performance management reviews are carried out for all staff which provide the
 opportunity to review successes, acknowledge personal targets and highlight areas for
 personal and professional development;
- a full and varied CPD programme is provided and our Menu of Learning Opportunities
 ensures each member of staff has a bespoke developmental programme which addresses
 their needs;
- a friendly and supportive staff team where colleagues help each other to succeed;

Oasis Academy Isle of Sheppey is situated across two Campuses - East (Minster-on-Sea) and West (Sheerness).

Situated on the Kent coast and with good motorway and rail connections, the Isle of Sheppey offers an ideal combination to enjoy the perfect work/life balance.

There is fast and easy access to the M2 and M20; and direct train services to Gillingham (12 mins), Canterbury (20 mins) and London less than an hour away. There is affordable housing in the immediate locality of the Academy and we are in an area of rapid regeneration.

Within the immediate vicinity, Sheerness offers good local facilities and there is a strong community programme of activities in which the Academy plays an important role. As the only secondary provision on the island, the Academy really is the hub of the local community.
