- quality assuring of all assessment, recording and reporting for their subject area (s)
- taking responsibility for the curriculum in their subject area (s)
- monitoring all matters of student conduct within their subject area (s), and supporting teachers in these areas
- maintaining up-to-date knowledge of developments in their subject area (s)
- to be responsible for the physical environment of the their subject area (s) area, creating an effective and stimulating learning environment
- to be responsible for the quality of cover work set in their subject area (s)
- to be responsible for monitoring the quality of homework in their subject area (s)
- to deputise for the D of L across the full range of duties when required
- to ensure teachers in their subject area (s) are aware of SEND, AMA and PP information for all students
