The Sevenoaks Specialist Teaching and Learning Service, led by Christine Reveley, is based at Valence School in Westerham. The Team is comprised of Specialist Teachers with specialisms in Early Years, Cognition and Learning, Social Emotional & Mental Health, Communication and Interaction, Hearing Impairment and Visual Impairment.

The Sevenoaks Specialist Teaching and Learning Service aims to work with SENCos and other professionals to provide high quality advice, support, information, training and outreach to mainstream pre-school settings, schools and parents through the Local Inclusion Forum Team (LIFT) referral process.

We work alongside pre-school settings, schools and other professionals in providing effective and co-ordinated support. Our aim is that children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities can have their learning, physical, social and emotional needs met, so that they can be fully included at school and make good educational progress.

We also work closely with outreach teams in other special schools, such as Milestone Academy. Representatives from the STLS and Outreach teams and other multi-agency professionals attend weekly referral meetings (Early Years LIFT / LIFT – Local Inclusion Forum Team).
