



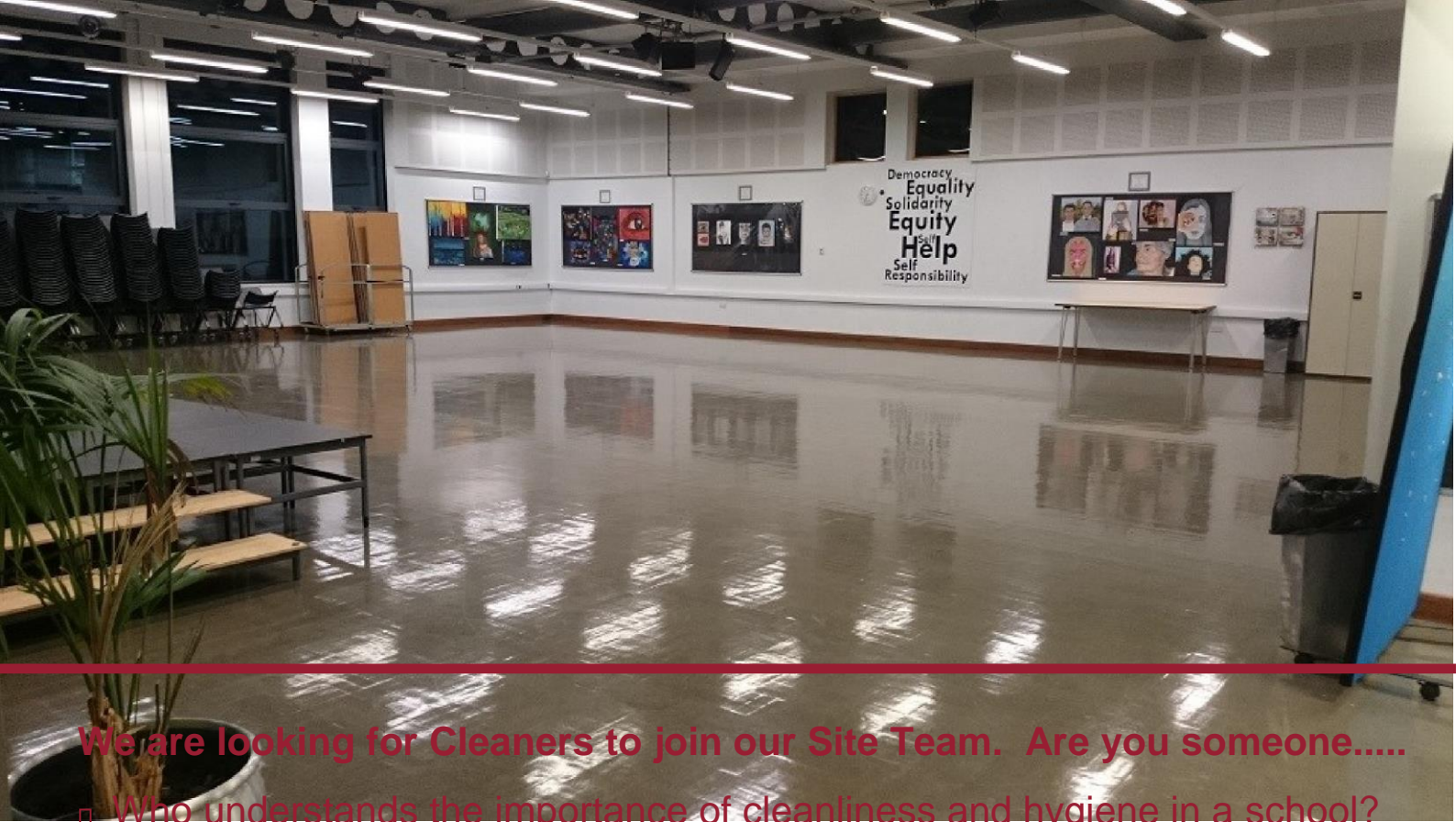

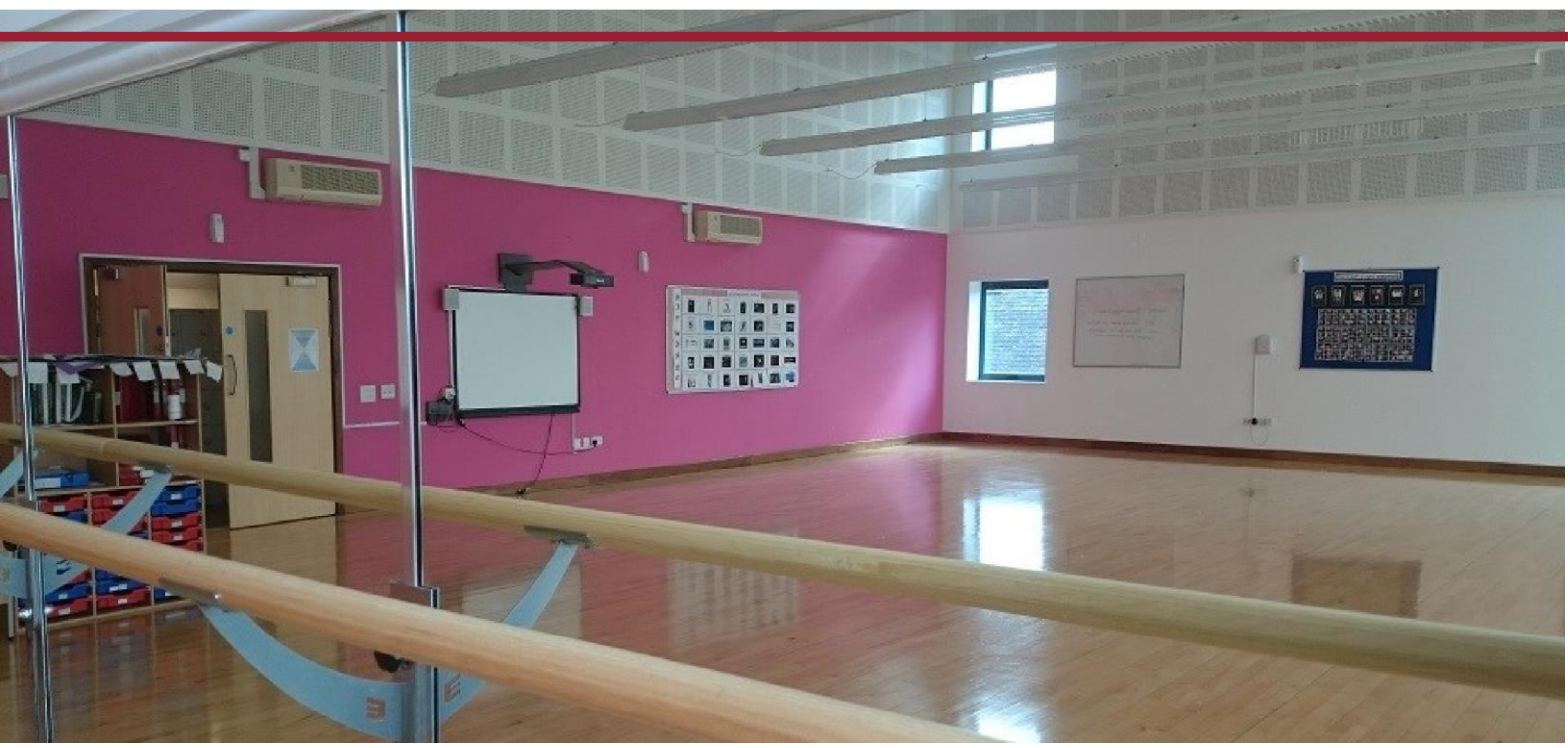

Holiday pay is included in the annual salary and there is no further holiday entitlement. Cleaning staff are part of the support staff team and are subject to the same procedures (including probation, absence and disciplinary policies) as all other staff.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Post : Cleaner

Responsible to: Site Manager and on-site Cleaning Supervisor

Hours per week: 15 hours
15.30 – 18.30 Monday - Friday

Weeks per year: 42 weeks -
Term time plus INSET Days plus 3 Weeks Deep Clean

KEY DUTIES, RESPONSIBILITIES and VALUES :

- To provide a comprehensive cleaning service of all allocated areas in line with specified standards and as directed. This will include dusting, vacuuming, washing floors, emptying bins etc to ensure high standards of cleanliness and hygiene at all times.
- To operate domestic and industrial cleaning equipment and materials, following appropriate training.
- To clean and maintain toilets to ensure hygiene standards are met, refilling and replacing any soap, towels and other materials as required.
- To store allocated equipment and materials safely and securely.
- To perform duties in line with health and safety regulations (COSHH) and take action where hazards are identified, reporting serious hazards to your line manager immediately.
- To collect and dispose of waste.
- To undertake during school closures or other designated periods a specialised cleaning programme or “deep clean” of all specified areas to ensure all areas are clean and fresh. This will involve undertaking both high and low level cleans within each area.
- Such other duties as the Principal or Governors may from time to time require.

This job description is not a comprehensive definition of the post. It will be reviewed regularly and may be subject to modification or amendment at any time after consultation with the post holder.
