Qualifications, Training and Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Relevant qualifications in the field of autism that demonstrate a thorough understanding of the needs of pupils with autism and how to support them.</li> <li>• MA in SEN/Autism or MA level SENDCo accreditation or willingness to undertake such qualification.</li> <li>• Qualified Teacher Status and evidence of appropriate subsequent in-service training and professional development.</li> <li>• Experience of working with pupils with autism, their parents/carers and other professionals.</li> <li>• Evidence of recent successful teaching experience in primary education or specialist settings.</li> <li>• Experience of monitoring and evaluating curriculum delivery and Teaching and Learning.</li> <li>• Evidence of sound understanding of a range of teaching styles and approaches appropriate for all pupils including those with special educational needs, a wide range of ability and a range of cultural backgrounds.</li> </ul>
