Job Description Class Teacher

Responsibilities:

- to carry out the duties of a school teacher as set out in the current School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document (subject to any amendments due to government legislation) and to perform to the requirements of the "Core" Professional Standards for Teachers. This includes any duties as may be reasonably directed by the Headteacher
- to provide a broad and balanced curriculum according to statutory requirements and the School's policies
- to be an effective teacher, providing engaging experiences which motivate and challenge children in an attractive and stimulating environment where they can achieve their best, incorporating outdoor learning
- to consistently and effectively plan lessons and sequences of lessons to meet pupils' individual learning needs
- to consistently and effectively use a range of appropriate strategies for teaching and classroom management
- to consistently and effectively use information about prior attainment to set appropriate expectations for pupil progress. To give clear and constructive feedback that enables reflection and improvement
- to demonstrate that, as a result of your teaching, your pupils achieve well relative to the pupils' prior attainment, making progress as good or better than similar pupils nationally. To follow school policies to address any concerns quickly and minimise the disruption to learning
- to have high expectations of children's behaviour and emotional wellbeing by modelling high standards of professional commitment and conduct at all times reflecting our ethos to achieve the highest standards
- to show a commitment to continual professional development and in-service training and use the outcomes to improve your teaching and pupils' learning
- to effectively manage and deploy Teaching Assistant support in the classroom when available to ensure that all support enhances learning
- be responsible for or have the potential to, provide professional leadership and management for an area of the curriculum by promoting high quality teaching and effective use of resources to improve standards of learning and achievement for all pupils
