Job Description Forest School - Specialist Learning Support Assistant

Reports to: Head of Faculty

Location: West Heath School – Sevenoaks, TN13 1SR

Hours: Term time only (39 weeks) Monday-Friday 8.30am-3.30pm

Main Purpose of the role:

Supporting the Learning Lodge Teacher to deliver forest school sessions, providing learners with opportunities to achieve and develop confidence and self-esteem through hands-on experiences in woodland and natural environment.

Physical Demands

The work requires moderate levels of physical effort. It involves lifting and handling of equipment and other resources and to be involved in practical activities and physical care of learners and the physical outdoor environment. The role is almost exclusively out of doors and will require working on uneven surfaces and in unpredictable weather conditions.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Support the Learning Lodge Teacher to implement Forest School ideals, creating a supporting and nurturing environment where students can develop confidence and self-esteem
- To prepare and support both inside and outside activities and resources, being prepared to be outside in all weathers, providing students with a positive example and role model
- To care and manage Learning Lodge equipment, supporting students in their use and ensuring that health and safety guidelines are in place
- To care for and upkeep the Learning Lodge area, keeping the work area fit for purpose
- To support the training of staff and students with Learning Lodge equipment
- To provide administrative support as required

Health and Safety:

 Working safely and hygienically at all times within Health and Safety Guidelines and Policies • To support all staff and students in keeping to specific Learning Lodge Health and Safety guidelines.

Partnership Working:

- Sustain and develop positive working partnerships with all areas of the Faculty and School
- Implement/monitor and contribute to joint initiatives as required
- To create and develop links between the department and wider school community
- Celebrate and share success with students, colleagues and parents/carers
