Evidence of the ability to maintain effective classroom discipline in a positive context and to promote well-ordered and self-disciplined behaviour throughout the school. Good ICT skills.

Evidence of a well-developed understanding of a range of teaching styles and approaches appropriate for children with special educational needs, a wide range of ability and a range of cultural backgrounds. Evidence of the ability to raise standards of achievement and of sustaining progress, especially for pupil premium pupils.
