The ability to work and communicate with a range of people at all levels, including young people, will be essential. The successful applicant will be flexible, pro-active in adapting to change and creative and practical. Knowledge of IT packages and to undertake a range of tasks is desirable.

General duties which apply to all subject areas:

- Provide support in lessons and occasionally lunchtimes across all key stages and subject areas
- To assist with and attend various departmental or school events eg open evenings, art & design technology exhibition
- To prepare stock orders and maintain stock levels across all subject areas
- To assist with the maintenance of displays and visual resources
- To prepare, photocopy and laminate resources
- To work with, and communicate effectively with, students in years 7-13 as well as working
- collaboratively with members of staff in the departments
- To be able to show a proactive, flexible and creative approach to tasks

The postholder is required to work for 39 weeks per year. The postholder will receive a payment in respect of their pro rata entitlement to Annual Leave appropriate to their grade, Bank Holidays and the KCC concessionary day which is included in the salary above.
