Specific Responsibilities

General Responsibilities

- 2) To attend meetings, as directed, for teaching assistants to discuss issues relating to the smooth running of the school, and the action required to meet the school's vision.
- 3) To attend meetings, as required by the Head of School and/or EYS Leading Practitioner
- 4) To understand and comply with a range of policies and procedures including child protection, health & safety in order to maintain a safe and secure learning environment.
- 5) TAs will be expected to work effectively with individual pupils and/or small groups under the direction and supervision of a class teacher.
- 6) To attend any course or school-based CPD to develop knowledge, skills and attributes to make a contribution in meeting the targets in the school improvement plan.
- 7) Keep a record of personal development e.g. monitoring feedback, CPD evaluations etc
- 8) To participate in the School's Appraisal System.
- 9) To engage in the induction process for new pupils to ensure they feel welcome and valued
- 10)To engage in the induction process for new members of staff to ensure they feel welcome and valued.
