

## Terms and Conditions

All participants will be deemed to have accepted, and be bound by, these terms and conditions, and by any other requirements set out in the promotional material as if they were set out in these terms and conditions.

1. Closing date for the competition is **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017** and entries must be received by 23:59 hrs on this date. If an individual or school is featured in the submitted idea (video or image), entrants must ensure that they have permission from the relevant parties for the image/clip to be used. Only entries that are supported by the relevant permissions from those involved in the clip will be considered.
2. There shall only be one prize winner in this competition.
3. The competition is open to UK residents aged 11-16, excluding employees from KCC and Councillors, their immediate families or anyone else professionally connected with the promotion.
4. No purchase is necessary for entry to the draw.
5. Entrants must seek permission from a parent or guardian before posting their idea on social media
6. The winner agrees to the use of their first name (only), and image in any promotional activity following the competition made in accordance with online safety policy and protection
